22nd Island Race - 6th September (96)

This year's Island Race sponsored by the Rush and Tompkin Group attracted 102 entries from over 30 clubs with competitors coming from as far afield as Burnham, Chesham, Harrow and Hayes Middlesex, Kings Lynn, Lewes, Milton Keynes, Nantwich and Sandbach Cheshire, Potters Bar and St. Albans, as well as part of Kent.

Whilst the race was threatened with a sea mist and no wind, conditions improved and all four starts at half hour intervals proceeded on time commencing at 10.30 a.m. All starts were affected by the light wind, particularly the first two starts for slow and medium handicap dinghies. However, the conditions improved as the wind filled in from the east and competitors enjoyed a full days sailing. Times varied considerably for the circumnavigation, the fastest catamaran taking 4 hours 21 mins 43 secs, whereas the slowest dinghy took 9 hours 14 mins 27 secs and was given a great cheer on going over the finish line.

Thirty classes of dinghies and catamarans took part with the larger fleets being Laser (14), GP14 (13), Scorpion (11), 505 (6), Mirror (6) and Enterprise (6).
